Eligibility

- All graduate students from all disciplines at UC Santa Barbara are eligible
- Student must be registered at UC Santa Barbara during the Spring quarter of the current academic year

Support

Awards from the Kline Fund will be between \$1500 and \$2500. UCSB students awarded this prize will also receive a one-to-one match to the Kline award. The UCSB recipient must be registered in the Spring Quarter of the current year.

Award Determination

Awardees will be notified in May. The award will be disbursed by the end of June of the current year.
