

HUMANITIES & SOCIAL SCIENCES RESEARCH GRANT

Overview

Award is given to assist talented graduate students in education, social sciences, fine arts, and humanities to pursue original research over the summer. Since these disciplines traditionally have limited access to extramural funds, this program's purpose is to help redress an imbalance in funding for graduate research. Doctoral or MFA domestic and international students may apply.

Eligibility

To be eligible, students:

- Must be advanced to candidacy at time of application or have completed at least 9 registered UCSB quarters up through the Spring quarter of the current academic year
- Must not have previously received this award
- Must be registered in the Spring quarter of the current academic year
- Must be in academic good standing at the time of application
- Must not be beyond time-to-degree standards through the Spring quarter of the current academic year

Support

Awards are for \$3,000 maximum. The committee may award a lesser amount than requested by the applicant. Awards will be disbursed in the summer quarter by the end of June. The student's faculty mentor is responsible for confirming the proposed activity does take place with expenses consistent with the awarded proposal.

Award Determination

Awards will be based on the academic significance and originality of the project, its feasibility-- especially within the specified time frame -- the qualifications of the applicant in relation to the project, and the clarity and appropriateness of the budget. Awards will not be given for research that has already been conducted. Awardees will be notified in May of the current year.

Application Materials

- This form (2 pages)
- Budget (page 2; Items **not** allowed are: conference travel; non-expendable equipment, such as computers, video cameras, etc; student salary; tuition/fees nor insurance. Payment of research subjects is allowable and must be labeled as such. Cost per subject, number of subjects, proposed hours, and rate of pay must be detailed.)
- Curriculum Vitae (2 page maximum, single-spaced)
- Description of research project/research interest (one to two pages, single-spaced)
Possible format of research project synopsis: Succinctly state your objective and the significance of your research. Clarifying components of the synopsis may include objective(s) of study, background/content of investigation, research approach and procedures, schedule of research, your qualifications and preparations for this project, anticipated results and significance of results.
- One letter of recommendation from the student's faculty mentor
