An ideal UCSB-CSU SRI Scholar candidate:

- Expresses a commitment to, and a strong potential for success in future pursuit of a Ph.D.
- Experienced educational barriers to their academic progress or expresses a commitment to addressing the barriers that prevent participation of students from underrepresented groups in graduate academic programs.
- Experienced situations or conditions that impacted their education advancement (e.g. the absence of a role model in your field of study, absence of a family member who received a four-year college degree or graduation from high school with poor financial or curricular support).
- Demonstrates leadership potential to address the issues of underrepresentation in postsecondary education.
- Possesses the potential to gain the personal and multicultural competency skills necessary to address the needs of a diverse state and global community through advanced education and research.

Awardee Eligibility:

This program is only open to U.S. citizens or permanent residents, or to students who hold AB540 or DACA status or believe they are eligible under this program. Student awardees must express a clear commitment to earning a doctoral degree. They must be full-time enrolled and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Awardees experience and commit to all components of a 7-week residential summer research program, which includes a slate of weekly workshops, upwards of 35 hours per week of research, and several social and networking events.

2. Statement of Interest (SOI):

Write a concise essay concerning your interest in the UCSB-CSU SRI program and graduate education in general. This essay should address (but is not limited to) the key components listed below. Please feel free to expand upon these components and share any additional information that you feel is relevant to your unique personal or educational history. Your statement should not exceed 1,000 words.

- Describe your research area of interest and, if applicable, prior and/or current research experience.
- Discuss why you are interested in participating in an undergraduate research program and what you feel you can gain from the experience.
- Discuss why you are interested in pursuing a doctoral degree and your future career objectives.
- Describe your educational background and achievements, providing information on barriers you may have personally faced and how you overcame them.

3. Resume/CV: Include a resume/CV with your application. Include any work or laboratory experience that you feel is relevant to your application.

4. Unofficial Transcripts: Include a copy of your unofficial transcripts with your application for your current undergraduate institution/university. If you are a master's degree student, submit your undergraduate transcripts and your current graduate degree transcripts.

5. One Letter of Recommendation: You will request a recommender complete this UCSB-CSU SRI Recommender Form, in which they will also be able to submit a letter. Additional information and directions are provided below. You may have more than one recommender but MUST have at least one.

You will submit your documents in Section 10 of this application. As documents are required, you will need to have them available to upload in order to complete and submit this application. The filenames must include your first and last names and clearly identify each document (examples: karen_vangool-SOI.pdf; karen_vangool-Resume.pdf; karen_vangool-Transcript.pdf).
