GRADUATE HUMANITIES RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP COVER SHEET 2021-22

Overview

The Graduate Humanities Research Fellowship is intended for doctoral students from the humanities or fine arts, or who are conducting research of a humanistic nature. This award is intended to free the student from employment obligations, enabling full attention to research.

Eligibility

Eligible nominees must be:

- Continuing doctoral (or Masters/Doctoral) graduate students
- Pursuing a degree in the humanities or fine arts or conducting research of a humanistic nature
- Advanced to doctoral candidacy at the time of nomination
- Demonstrating high academic performance and in good academic standing.
- Have requisite Spring 2021 registration or Spring 2021 official Leave Of Absence status at the time of nomination
- Within time-to-degree standards

Students are not eligible if:

Application Materials

This form

- Hold an active multi-year central fellowship package (e.g. students in a departmental appointment year of a multi-year award)
- Research projects are non-humanistic in nature
- Received the Humanities Research Assistantship twice previously during the student's academic career at UCSB

Support

The grant provides a fellowship of approximately \$24,000 plus payment of in-state tuition including university health insurance. Departments may supplement with any combination of appointments up to an average of 35% time over the course of the academic year. (In these cases, Graduate Student Fee Remission will pay fees/insurance from the salary account. Graduate Division will pay the balance of fees if needed.)
