

Dissertation Fellowship Match Program

Exceptional students across all disciplines benefit from the Dissertation Fellowship Match program, in which gifts from donors are enhanced with additional funding to create full support packages. The fellowship frees up the awardee from teaching and/or non-academic employment obligations, enabling full attention to dissertation writing.

Program Features

- Donations are matched on 2:1 basis with a \$36,000 gift matched with \$18,000 from the Graduate Division to provide a full-year fellowship of \$54,000
- Donors can provide a shorter, quarter-long dissertation fellowship with a \$12,000 gift that is matched by \$6,000 from the Graduate Division, perfect for students that are nearing the completion of their writing
- The fellowship funds tuition, fees, and health insurance while also providing a generous stipend
